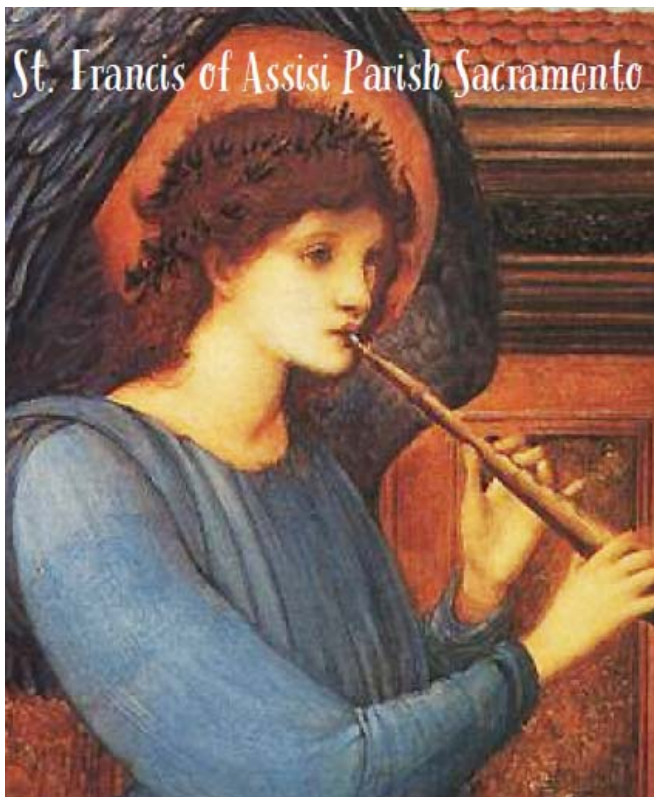

## DIRECTOR OF MUSIC: NOW ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS



### Director of Music for St. Francis of Assisi Parish -

a vibrant Catholic community in the tradition of St. Francis and St. Clare, located in Sacramento, CA. We are an inclusive community, respecting the dignity of all persons and supporting the journey of each person.

Candidates should have a minimum of a Bachelor's degree, preferably in music, theology, religious studies, or similar religious background and experience. Candidates should also demonstrate proficient keyboard and choral conducting skills, vocal technique, and be familiar with music notation software. A practicing Catholic is preferred but not required, however candidates must have a firm foundation in Catholic liturgy and Vatican II theology, and be conversant with a variety of liturgical styles including contemporary, classical, and traditional. We are looking for a music director who is willing to execute music planning for the liturgical year in collaboration with the parish Director of Liturgy, the Liturgy Team, and the Pastor, with a collective approach that encourages our assembly to sing. Working hours are flexible and include weekends and some evenings.

Responsibilities include planning, coordinating and presenting music at weekend liturgies, funerals, and other liturgical celebrations; Recruit, rehearse, and conduct ensembles at weekly rehearsals; Coordinate over 200 volunteers which include three adult choirs, children's choir, cantors, and instrumentalists.

This is a full-time non-exempt position with benefits. Compensation commensurate with experience and qualifications and in accordance with Diocesan guidelines. Remuneration for liturgical music provided at funerals and weddings is outside of compensation for this position.
