

The Church ushers in a new liturgical year this weekend, the *First Sunday of Advent*. Advent is about waiting...waiting for the birth of Christ in Bethlehem, and waiting also for his Second Coming at the end of time. But the waiting is not passive. We stand watch so as not to be caught asleep. We wait in hope, knowing that there is more than the darkness, that even as we wait for Jesus, we know that He is with us.

The Season of Advent brings with it a different look. Liturgically, we make room for watchful anticipation.... the lighting of the Advent candles... an empty creche... praying for God's mercy in the Confiteor... putting away the Gloria to await its return at the first Mass of Christmas....

On the **Third Sunday of Advent**, we participate in the tradition of recent Popes, bringing the baby Jesus figures from our home nativity scenes for a blessing.

## THE THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT - GAUDETE SUNDAY

Each Mass has its own "entrance antiphon." This is a sentence or two, most often from the scriptures. We can sing it at the beginning of Mass (although, in the U.S., we usually begin Mass by singing a hymn instead of the antiphon). Years ago, people gave a title to each Sunday's Mass. The title came from the first Latin word of the day's antiphon.

The entrance antiphon for the Third Sunday of Advent begins, "Rejoice in the Lord always." These words are from St. Paul's Letter to the Philippians. In Latin, "rejoice" is gaudete. So today is called Gaudete Sunday.

Why should we rejoice on this day in the middle of Advent? The antiphon tells us why: "Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I say, rejoice! The Lord is near."


#### Daily Reflections for Advent & Christmas

## Bambinelli Sunday
