





# GETTING TO KNOW ST. CLARE OF ASSIST

### St. Clare's story continued...

In the year 1215 the restrictive Fourth Lateran Council was convened. Its idea of reform was to contain and control all religious groups under Church jurisdiction. Unity was to be achieved by uniformity. Hugolino's Rule in 1219 dictated to the women how they were to live; and all would be subject to strict enclosure.

While Clare was dealing with the institutional church, Francis was occupied with writing a Rule for the Brothers. The papacy refused to approve the Earlier Rule of 1221. He then composed another with the help of Canonists and Hugolino himself. This Later Rule was approved by Pope Honorius III in 1223.. After this, Francis embarked on a mission which included his recreation of the Christmas event in Greccio, his visit to the Sulian Al-Malik Al-Kamil, and his retreat at La Verna, filled with doubt and sorrow, where he received the Stigmata.

Six months later he went to San Damiano for care. He had many physical illmesses and developed an eye disease that caused great pain. Clare had the great Joy of his presence and being able to serve him in this time of need. Out of that pain and darkness, Francis composed his Canticle of the Sun. With death drawing ever closer, he asked to be taken to the Portiuncula where Sister Death visited him on the night of October 3, 1226. The next day his body was taken to San Damiano on its way to the funeral. There Clare and her Sisters were able to give voice to their grief.

Soon St. Clare will join her soul mate in this church.


