Pathways for Justice presents Catholic Social Teaching in Action: The Dignity of Work and the Rights of Workers

Pope Francis has said: "Not paying fairly, not giving a job because you are only looking at how to make a profit, that goes against God." Catholic Social Teaching tells us that the economy must serve people, not the other way around. Work is more than a way to make a living; it is a form of continuing participation in God's creation. And if the dignity of work is to be protected then the rights of workers must be respected.

This teaching forms the basis for discussion at the seventh St. Francis Pathways for Justice quarterly series on Catholic Social Teaching in Action. Our speakers will be:

- Monica Marcelli-Chu, Ph.D., Professor of Theological Ethics at the Jesuit School of Theology, Santa Clara University. Dr. Chu specializes in moral theology and the works of St. Thomas Aquinas; she will speak on the history of this teaching and how we can apply it in our lives.
- Jim Durst of Durst Organic Growers. Mr. Durst, a local farmer and worker advocate, will share what his company does to promote the rights and dignity of workers.


Looking for a way to deepen your prayer life in response to the Lenten call to prayer, fasting, and almsgiving?






APOSTLE'S CREED
