FATHER MYCHAL JUDGE (1933-2001)

Fr. Mychal Judge was the Franciscan Chaplain who responded to the scene of the destruction of the twin towers at the World Trade Center with the firefighters with whom he served on Sept. 11, 2001. Fr. Mychal was listed as the first certified casualty of 9/11. He joined the Franciscans at the age of 15 and was widely known for his ministry among the poor and homeless, alcoholics, and people with AIDS.

Fr. Mychal lived with this simple spirituality: "God is not an obligation or a burden. God is the joy of my life!"
